DecoArt has created a new section on their website titled "Come Paint With Us!". You will find painting lessons, product information and how-to videos. You can download and print out a brushstroke guide which may be helpful if you are teaching. You can order painting kits on the site as well. Video Lesson 1 is a beginner clipboard project with a demo in basecoating, finger dots, penwork, sideloading, dots and linework by Shara Reiner. 43 minutes long. Lesson 2 is fruit coasters painted with strokework, sideloading, and doubleloading with Lynne Deptula. Video is one hour and 14 minutes long. Lesson 3 is a floral notepad teaching strokework with Judy Diephouse. This lesson is 54 minutes long. Each lesson has suggestions for utilizing the designs. Other video tutorials are available on the site. http://decoart.com/comepaintwithus/ If you haven't visited Patricia Rawlinson's website recently you are in for a treat with her new DecoArt Americana Paint Converter! All you have to do is type in the Delta, Plaid or Jo Sonja paint color name and press a button... up pops the

Color White – Simple and purity are two words that describe this color. For marketing it is often seen used with black, or with health related products. Most brands won't only use white, many use white in at least some part of their color scheme, including Apple, Volkswagen and Tylenol.

Paint Storage Tip: Use file cabinet drawers and store the paints upside down.

By storing the bottles upside down the air can't get at the paints so they won't dry out. The paints should be kept away from any heat source and out of direct sunlight.
