
Message from the President.....



MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Happy New Year to all! It's hard to believe that it's already clicking along at a pretty fast pace. For those that may not know I'm Sherry Flowers and your 2017 Membership

As of January 10, 2017 we have 35 members. We encourage you to spread the word about our chapter and refer anyone interested to our website <u>www.RockyMountainHiArtists.com</u> where a Membership Application can be downloaded, printed and completed for submission. Also, I'm happy to send an email to anyone interested with the application attached, which provides the address for you to send your \$20 (Local Chapter annual dues).

Society of Decorative Painters annual dues (\$50) must be sent directly to National at our new address: Society of Decorative Painters (SDP), 1220 East First Street, Wichita, KS 67214. You can also contact SDP by phone at (316) 269-9300 ext. 101 or email to <u>sdp@decorativepainters.org</u>

I thought it would be of value to clarify the Membership Guidelines since SDP in 2016 amended our calendar year membership cycle (January through December) to an anniversary date membership cycle (one year from your official join date). The following information is FAQ's from SDP.

If you were a member in January 2016, your membership remains on a calendar year cycle (January 1 through December 31). As long as your renewal payment is received by your expiration date (December 31) each year, nothing changes.

Q: What if my membership is currently on a calendar year and I renew after my expiration date? You may have a new anniversary date. For example, if your renewal payment is not received until April 10, 2017, then your membership would be from April 1, 2017 through March 30, 2018.

Q: I joined SDP under the 2016 Pro-Rated Membership. When does my membership end? If you joined under our 2016 Pro-Rated Membership option between September 2016 and December 2016, your membership is still on the calendar year cycle and will end on December 31, 2017.

Q: For new members, does it matter what day of the month they join? Yes. If an individual's

membership dues are received between the 1st and the 15th, his/her official start date is the 1st of that month. If an individual's membership dues are received between the 16th and the 31st, his/her official start date is the 1st of the following month. For example, someone who joins on February 18, 2017 will have an effective date of March 1, 2017 and an expiration date of February 28, 2018.

Your SDP membership and Chapter membership will be on the same cycle.

Just a friendly reminder, as we start a new year, one very important Standing Rule is that "A guest may attend only two (2) meetings before joining the organization.
