

Elissa McAlear posted the minutes from the January General Meeting.

Pate Greene - Treasurer - \$4,906.34 was the balance and she has some checks to pay out.

Kathy Beck - Membership - Roster books are to be signed for and those not at the meeting will be mailed. The membership is 43. Kathy Beck passed out to new members a kit which was cleverly put together with a cup with our emblem, a brush, ByLaws, a charm and Chapter business card.

Verlene Siska - Newsletter - the deadline to submit articles is Sunday, April 12th at 1 PM.

Melinda Barnes - Travel Seminars - Chris Thornton's June seminars are almost full. The large metal ornament is \$21 each and there will be preparation instructions to be done before the class. Questions may be answered by Sherry Flowers and Marilyn Corners. Marilyn has a background screen and an extra card table for the cash or check sales. There will be no painting demonstration. Hand painted items and painted jewelry are requested donations from members. Please sign up for your painted contributions and include an approximate cost of the items. We need everyone's participation to make this a worthwhile project, so keep those brushes moving!

Linda Bierman - Cookbook - **We need 150 to 200 recipes for our 40th Anniversary Cookbook.** Member's artwork will be featured on the category dividers. The artwork needs to be original or credited to original artist. Marilyn Corners and Ginny Sparlin are working on the cover.

You may call Linda Bierman or Ginny Sparlin for assistance with these postings. **May 1st is the deadline for recipe submissions. You will find many videos on her website showing you how to use a tool and how to paint with many different techniques. Be sure and take a look at her New Products in the menu. I noticed Patty is using a lot of lettering stencils recently and the results are dramatic. She also has stencils for about anything you can think of and shows you how to use them in your backgrounds under the painting. You will also find many embellishments that are so fun! One of her new items is LED lights in all colors, with a wire so you can arrange the lights any way you want them. This string of lights can be removed easily and be used for different projects during the year. Oh... did I mention they are battery operated and some have a timer. *grin*

I'm not sure this link will work because it is so long, but here goes. This project caught my eye because Patty said you can complete it (from basecoating to finish) in 1 1/2 hours! It is a stand with the letters spelling out 'Spooky'. That sounds plain, but she embellishes it with stencils and two different sizes of bats cutouts. You have to see this one to appreciate it.

DecoArt has a new line called **Americana Decor Maxx Gloss Finish**. This paint can be used on furniture and accessories. The end result is a very high gloss finish. Also water-based and brush-on formula in 26 colors. Once fully cured it is highly resistant to household cleaning chemicals so for furniture it would be great to use.

DecoArt has expanded their line of stencils. From backgrounds to letters. I think I am seeing a trend toward lettering recently! **DecoArt** also introduced a **DuraClear High Gloss** varnish which can be used inside or outside and highly resistant to household chemical cleaners. Their **Chalky Finish** line continues to be very popular and available in 2 ounce bottles now. Here is a link to useful information about the Chalky paints.

DecoArt is introducing a line of **Decou-Page Paper**. It is available in packages of three coordinating designs. One important note about their **Decou-Page** is it dishwasher safe and adheres to about any surface.

Dear Donna,

Q: I have painted my surface with your Craft Twinkles line of products but I still see some of the surface showing through...

A: For the best results using **Craft Twinkles/Glamour Dust Glitter**, basecoat your surface with a similar color of acrylic first. It's amazing how this will make the glitter color pop. For example, when using red Craft Twinkles, basecoat the surface with Santa Red first. Let dry, then apply Red Craft Twinkles with a fan brush. For the smoothest finish, avoid brushing back and forth too much when applying Craft Twinkles or any glitter paints.

DETERMINE THE SELLING PRICE AND WE WILL TAG.** For example cards bundled in five packs could be priced at \$15. Individual cards may be priced at \$4. A small batik could be priced at \$12, a hand painted charger at \$25, etc. You are the one that best knows the worth, but I'm happy to assist as is the Board.

PACKAGING: BUNDLING CARDS CAN BE DONE VERY SIMPLY WITH RIBBON OR RAFFIA OR PLACING AN INDIVIDUAL CARD IN A SLEEVE. PICTURES CAN BE MATTED AND/OR PLACED IN A LARGE SLEEVE. FRAMING IS ANOTHER OPTION. WHATEVER YOU DO IT WILL BE FABULOUS.
