This month we will be painting place mats on multi-purpose roc-lon . These place mats will be used for the luncheon/art show on September 13th.


Please bring fabric scissors, sea sponges, painting board larger than 12 x 18, and your acrylic supplies (brushes, palette knife, water container, paper towels, newspaper, hair dryer). The chapter will be supplying the acrylic paints and fabric.

The techniques we will be using will be a little different than the techniques we explored in June. Be sure and come out and support the chapter. Besides you would not want someone less talented than yourself to paint place mats for you and your guest!!!;

This year's luncheon/art show theme is 'Autumn Leaves of Red and Gold.' The place mat design was not quite finished in time to put in newsletter deadline, but I hope to send you a copy of the design before we meet on Monday. If you find this design not to your liking, you are welcome to use a design that best fits your personal taste, but please limit your choice to leaves and autumn colors.

Speaking of the art show, this year it will be held at Blossom's at Heather Gardens, 2888 S Heather Gardens Way, Aurora, CO 80014.

Please be aware that Blackhawk Street is closed due to construction. If you are taking the highway get off on the Parker North exit rather than Iliff, then go left on Peoria, then right onto E Yale. There is a drive way that you can use to unload you paintings and then you can park in front of the building or there is another parking lot on the north side of the tennis courts.
